DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: Noncode.

Synopsis: State disaster relief fund appropriation. Makes an appropriation to the state disaster relief fund to provide financial assistance to eligible entities affected by lead contamination in East Chicago.

Effective: July 1, 2017; July 1, 2018.

SENATE BILL No. 317

A BILL FOR AN ACT concerning disaster relief and to make an appropriation.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2017] (a) **Beginning July 1,**
2 **2017, and ending June 30, 2018, there is appropriated to the state**
3 **disaster relief fund established by IC 10-14-4-5 two million five**
4 **hundred thousand dollars (\$2,500,000) from the state general fund**
5 **to be used by the department of homeland security to provide**
6 **financial assistance to eligible entities (as defined in IC 10-14-4-2)**
7 **affected by lead contamination in East Chicago.**

8 (b) **The limitation in IC 10-14-4-5(a) specifying that financial**
9 **assistance may be provided only from the balance in the state**
10 **disaster relief fund that is unobligated on the date the disaster**
11 **occurs does not apply to money appropriated to the state disaster**
12 **relief fund under this SECTION.**

13 (c) **This SECTION expires July 1, 2018.**

14 SECTION 2. [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2018] (a) **Beginning July 1,**
15 **2018, and ending June 30, 2019, there is appropriated to the state**
16 **disaster relief fund established by IC 10-14-4-5 two million five**
17 **hundred thousand dollars (\$2,500,000) from the state general fund**
