DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 20-33-8-34.

Synopsis: Discipline of students with disabilities. Provides that if a student with a disability is suspended or expelled for an incident in which the student causes a classroom disturbance, the student's case conference committee must be convened not later than 10 school days after the date of the incident to consider the appropriateness of an alternative placement for the student. Makes a technical correction.

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning education.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

- (2) rules adopted by the state board.
- (b) The division of special education shall propose rules under IC 20-35-2-1(b)(5) to the state board for adoption under IC 4-22-2 governing suspensions, expulsions, and other disciplinary action for a student who is a student with a disability (as defined in IC 20-35-1-8).
- (c) If a student who is a student with a disability (as defined in IC 20-35-1-8) is suspended or expelled for an incident in which the student causes a classroom disturbance, the student's case conference committee must be convened not later than ten (10)
