DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 20-34-3-22.

Synopsis: CDC Youth Risk Behaviors Survey. Requires the state department of health to notify the department of education if the federal Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) notifies the state department of health that a public high school is identified to participate in the CDC's Youth Risk Behaviors Survey (survey). Provides that the department of education is required to notify the public high school that the school is required to participate in the survey. Requires a public high school to participate in the survey.

SENATE BILL No. 323

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning education.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

SECTION 1. IC 20-34-3-22 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
AS A NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY
1, 2018]: Sec. 22. (a) If the state department of health is notified by
the federal Centers for Disease Control and Prevention that it has
identified a public high school to participate in the Youth Risk
Behaviors Survey of the federal Centers for Disease Control and
Prevention or a successor survey, the state department of health
shall notify the department of the request.

(b) If the department receives notification from the state department of health under subsection (a), the department shall notify the public high school that the school is required to participate in the survey described in subsection (a) and that schools are required to make the survey available to all high school students. The department shall notify the schools of the provisions of IC 20-30-5-17, and schools shall abide by those provisions.
