DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 13-11-2-82; IC 13-20-9.2.

Synopsis: Ban on disposal of recyclable materials. Provides that items consisting entirely or primarily of paper, cardboard, glass, aluminum, or plastic may not be disposed of or incinerated in a final disposal facility. Authorizes the environmental rules board to adopt rules.

Effective: July 1, 2014.
