DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 5-14-3.8-3.

Synopsis: Transparency portal. Requires the department of local government finance to post on the Indiana transparency Internet web site a contract of a political subdivision during each year that the contract amount payable by the political subdivision for the year exceeds the lesser of: (1) 10% of the political subdivision's property tax levy; or (2) \$50,000.

Effective: July 1, 2016.

5	(5) Local development agreement reports prepared under

7	(6) Information for evaluating the fiscal health of a political

1	subdivision in the format required by section 8(b) of this chapter.
2	(7) Any other financial information deemed appropriate by the

4	(8) A digital image of a contract shall be posted during each
5	year that the contract amount to be paid by a political
6	subdivision for that year exceeds the lesser of:
7	(A) ten percent (10%) of the political subdivision's
8	property tax levy for that year; or
9	(B) fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000).
