DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 16-19-3-32.

Synopsis: Department of health reversion. Provides that money appropriated to the state department of health for a state fiscal year that remains unexpended and unencumbered at the close of the state fiscal year does not revert to the state general fund and is not subject to transfer, assignment, or reassignment to any other fund or purpose.

Effective: Upon passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning health.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

3	UPON PASSAGE]: Sec. 32. Notwithstanding IC 4-13-2-19 or any
4	other law, money appropriated to the state department of health
5	for a state fiscal year that remains unexpended and unencumbered
6	at the close of the state fiscal year:
7	(1) does not revert to the state general fund, but remains
8	available for the initial purpose of the appropriation in
9	subsequent state fiscal years; and
10	(2) is not subject to transfer to any other fund or to transfer,
11	assignment, or reassignment for any other use or purpose by:
12	(A) the state board of finance notwithstanding IC 4-9.1-1-7,
13	IC 4-13-2-23, or any other law; or
14	(B) the budget agency or any other state agency,
15	notwithstanding IC 4-12-1-12 or any other law.
16	SECTION 2. An emergency is declared for this act.
