## SENATE BILL No. 335

#### DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

**Citations Affected:** IC 14-8-2-294.5; IC 14-18-10-2.

**Synopsis:** Utility easements. Defines "utility" for purposes of IC 14-18-10 (the law concerning utility easements) to include a communications service provider. Provides that the director of the department of natural resources may not impose a charge to issue a permit to erect or construct a utility line upon or across a public highway right-of-way that passes through state land.

Effective: July 1, 2015.

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning natural and cultural resources.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

7	FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2015]: Sec. 2. The director may
8	issue to any person, without charge, a permit to erect or construct a
9	utility, telephone, or telegraph line as described in section 1 of this
10	chapter under the rules and restrictions that the director considers
11	necessary:
12	(1) for the protection and preservation of the natural scenic
13	conditions of the land; or
14	(2) to prevent the line from interfering with or obstructing the use
15	and enjoyment of the property by the public.
16	However, the director shall not impose a charge to issue a permit



- to erect or construct a utility, telephone, or telegraph line as described in section 1(5) of this chapter.
