DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 20-30-5-7.

Synopsis: Study of ethnic history. Requires the study of ethnic and racial groups to be included as part of each school corporation's high school United States history course.

Effective: July 1, 2017.

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A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning education.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 20-30-5-7, AS AMENDED BY P.L.86-2007,
2 SECTION 1, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
3 JULY 1, 2017]: Sec. 7. Each school corporation shall include in the
4 school corporation's curriculum the following studies:
5 (1) Language arts, including:
6 (A) English;
7 (B) grammar;
8 (C) composition;
9 (D) speech; and
10 (E) second languages.
11 (2) Mathematics.
12 (3) Social studies and citizenship, including the:
13 (A) constitutions;
14 (B) governmental systems; and
15 (C) histories;
16 of Indiana and the United States, including a study of the
17 Holocaust **and the study of ethnic and racial groups**, in each



- 1 high school United States history course.
- 2 (4) Sciences.
- 3 (5) Fine arts, including music and art.
- 4 (6) Health education, physical fitness, safety, and the effects of
- 5 alcohol, tobacco, drugs, and other substances on the human body.
- 6 (7) Additional studies selected by each governing body, subject
- 7 to revision by the state board.
