SENATE BILL No. 337

DIGEST OF SB 337 (Updated February 8, 2017 4:25 pm - DI 110)

Citations Affected: IC 20-30.

Synopsis: Study of ethnic and racial groups course. Requires each: (1) school corporation; (2) charter school; and (3) accredited nonpublic school; to offer the study of ethnic and racial groups as a one semester elective course in its high school curriculum at least once every school year. Provides that, if fewer than 15 students of a public school, a charter school, or an accredited nonpublic school enroll in a study of ethnic and racial groups course, the public school, charter school, or accredited nonpublic school may offer the course as an independent study course.

Effective: July 1, 2017.

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning education.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

12	(3) Social studies and citizenship, including the:

14	(B) governmental systems; and
15	(C) histories;

2 (5) Fine arts, including music and art.

3 (6) Health education, physical fitness, safety, and the effects of 4

7 (b) Each:

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(1) school corporation;

(2) charter school; and

(3) accredited nonpublic school;

11 shall offer the study of ethnic and racial groups as a one (1) 12 semester elective course in its high school curriculum at least once 13 every school year. Except as provided under subsection (c), a 14 course described in this subsection may not be offered as an 15 independent study course.

16 (c) If fewer than fifteen (15) students of a public school, a 17 charter school, or an accredited nonpublic school enroll in a course 18 described in subsection (a), the public school, charter school, or 19 accredited nonpublic school may offer the course as an 20 independent study course.

COMMITTEE REPORT

Madam President: The Senate Committee on Education and Career Development, to which was referred Senate Bill No. 337, has had the same under consideration and begs leave to report the same back to the Senate with the recommendation that said bill be AMENDED as follows:

Page 1, line 3, after "7." insert "(a)".

Page 1, line 17, delete "and the study of ethnic and racial groups,". Page 2, after line 7, begin a new paragraph and insert:

"(b) Each:

(1) school corporation;

(2) charter school; and

(3) accredited nonpublic school;

shall offer the study of ethnic and racial groups as a one (1) semester elective course in its high school curriculum at least once every school year. Except as provided under subsection (c), a course described in this subsection may not be offered as an independent study course.

(c) If fewer than fifteen (15) students of a public school, a charter school, or an accredited nonpublic school enroll in a course described in subsection (a), the public school, charter school, or accredited nonpublic school may offer the course as an independent study course."

and when so amended that said bill do pass.
