DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 12-17.2-7.2.

Synopsis: Prekindergarten pilot program. Provides that, after June 30, 2019, in addition to the counties currently participating in the prekindergarten pilot program (program), the program includes eligible providers in any county in Indiana. Provides that the total amount of grants the office of the secretary of family and social services (office) awards to eligible children in certain participating counties during a state fiscal year may not be less than the total amount of grants the office awarded to eligible children in that county during the immediately preceding state fiscal year unless the office determines that there is an insufficient number of eligible children or eligible providers in the county to justify the total amount of grants for that county.

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning education.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1	SECTION 1. IC 12-17.2-7.2-2, AS AMENDED BY P.L.184-2017,
2	SECTION 14, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
3	JULY 1, 2019]: Sec. 2. As used in this chapter, "eligible provider"
4	refers to a provider that satisfies the following conditions:
5	(1) The provider is:
6	(A) a:
7	(i) public school, including a charter school;
8	(ii) child care center licensed under IC 12-17.2-4;
9	(iii) child care home licensed under IC 12-17.2-5; or
10	(iv) child care ministry registered under IC 12-17.2-6;
11	that meets the standards of quality recognized by a Level 3 or
12	Level 4 paths to QUALITY program rating;
13	(B) a school that is accredited by the state board of education
14	or a national or regional accreditation agency that is
15	recognized by the state board of education; or
16	(C) a school that is accredited to provide qualified early
17	education services by an accrediting agency approved by the

2	(2) The provider:
3	(A) provides qualified early education services to eligible
4	children; and
5	(B) complies with the agreement with the office concerning
6	the delivery of qualified education services and the use of a
7	grant provided under this chapter.
8	(3) The provider:
9	(A) is located in a county in which the prekindergarten pilot
10	program is implemented; or
11	(B) meets the requirements of section 7(h) of this chapter.
12	SECTION 2. IC 12-17.2-7.2-7, AS AMENDED BY P.L.184-2017,
13	SECTION 19, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
14	JULY 1, 2019]: Sec. 7. (a) The office may establish a prekindergarten
15	pilot program to provide grants for:
16	(1) qualified early education services in a manner consistent with
17	how funds are distributed under the Child Care and Development
18	Fund (CCDF) grant program; and
19	(2) expansion plans as described in section 7.4(a)(2) of this
20	chapter.
21	(b) The office shall administer the prekindergarten pilot program.
22	The prekindergarten pilot program may include:
23	(1) eligible providers in the counties described in subsections (c)
24	and (d); Indiana; and
25	(2) potential eligible providers or existing eligible providers as
26	described in section 7.4 of this chapter.
27	The office shall ensure that the counties selected include a population
28	of eligible children sufficient to conduct the longitudinal study under
29	section 12 of this chapter.
30	(c) Before July 1, 2017, the prekindergarten pilot program includes
31	eligible providers in the following pilot counties:
32	(1) Allen.
33	(2) Jackson.
34	(3) Lake.
35	(4) Marion.
36	(5) Vanderburgh.
37	The total amount of grants the office awards to eligible children in a
38	county listed in this subsection during a state fiscal year may not be
39	less than the total amount of grants the office awarded to eligible
40	children in that county during the immediately preceding state fiscal
41	year unless the office determines that there is an insufficient number of
42	eligible children or eligible providers in the county to justify the total

1	amount of grants for that county.
2	(d) After June 30, 2017, and before July 1, 2019, in addition to the
3	counties listed under subsection (c), the prekindergarten pilot program
4	includes the following:
5	(1) eligible providers in fifteen (15) additional counties.
6	(2) Eligible providers described in subsection (h) regardless of
7	whether the eligible providers are located in a county described
8	in subsection (c) or subdivision (1).
9	In determining which counties are designated as pilot counties under
10	subdivision (1), this subsection, the office shall give preference to
11	counties that are primarily rural. The total amount of grants the
12	office awards to eligible children in a county designated under this
13	subsection during a state fiscal year may not be less than the total
14	amount of grants the office awarded to eligible children in that
15	county during the immediately preceding state fiscal year unless
16	the office determines that there is an insufficient number of eligible
17	children or eligible providers in the county to justify the total
18	amount of grants for that county.
19	(e) After June 30, 2019, in addition to the counties listed in
20	subsection (c) and counties designated under subsection (d), the
21	prekindergarten program includes eligible providers in any county
22	in Indiana.
23	(e) (f) Subject to the requirements of this chapter, the office shall
24	determine:
25	(1) the eligibility requirements, application process, and selection
26	process for awarding grants under the prekindergarten pilot
27	program;
28	(2) the administration and reporting requirements for:
29	(A) eligible providers; and
30	(B) potential eligible providers or existing eligible providers;
31	participating in the prekindergarten pilot program; and
32	(3) with the assistance of the early learning advisory committee,
33	an appropriate outcomes based accountability system for:
34	(A) eligible providers; and
35	(B) potential eligible providers or existing eligible providers.
36	(f) (g) Before implementing the prekindergarten pilot program, the
37	office shall submit the provisions of the prekindergarten pilot program
38	to the state board of education for the state board of education's review
39	and comment.
40	(g) (h) The office shall, subject to the availability of funding,
41	determine the number of eligible children who will participate in the
42	prekindergarten pilot program.

2	(1) received a matching grant under IC 12-17.2-3.6 (before its
3	repeal) in the state fiscal year beginning after June 30, 2016, and

7	(3) participates in the prekindergarten pilot program each year
8	continuously, beginning with the year the eligible provider is
9	eligible to participate in the prekindergarten pilot program under

16	the prekindergarten pilot program. However, this subsection does not
17	affect the eligibility of an eligible provider that is located in a county
18	described in subsection (c) or (d)(1).
