DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 8-23-2-21.

Synopsis: Construction of certain intersections. Provides that the Indiana department of transportation (department) may not engage in planning or perform construction to install a roundabout or a reduced conflict intersection until the department has received input and approval from the legislative body of the unit that has control over the intersection or junction where the roundabout or reduced conflict intersection would be located.

Effective: July 1, 2023.

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning transportation.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

3	1, 2023]: Sec. 21. (a) As used in this section, "legislative body"
4	means the following:
5	(1) The board of county commissioners, for a county not

7	(2) The county council, for a county subject to IC 36-2-3.5.
8	(3) The city-county council, for a consolidated city or county
9	having a consolidated city.
0	(4) The common council, for a city other than a consolidated
1	city.
2	(5) The town council, for a town.
3	(6) The township board, for a township.
4	(7) The governing body of any other political subdivision that
5	has a governing body.
6	(8) The chief executive officer of any other political
7	subdivision that does not have a governing body.



1	(b) As used in this section, "reduced conflict intersection"
2	means an intersection that modifies:
3	(1) direct left-turn and through movements from cross street
4	approaches; or
5	(2) direct left turns from major approaches.
6	(c) As used in this section, "roundabout" means a circular
7	intersection or junction in which road traffic flows almost
8	continuously in one (1) direction around a central island.
9	(d) As used in this section, "unit" means a county, municipality.
10	township, or political subdivision.
11	(e) The department may not:
12	(1) engage in planning; or
13	(2) perform construction;
14	to install a roundabout or a reduced conflict intersection until the
15	department has received input and approval from the legislative
16	body of the unit that has control over the intersection or junction
17	where the roundabout or reduced conflict intersection would be
18	located.
