# SENATE BILL No. 361

### DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 14-22-20-1.

**Synopsis:** Dog training in game breeder enclosures. Provides that a game breeder's license may be issued to permit: (1) the training of hunting dogs; and (2) the conducting of field trials; within a game breeder enclosure for certain game birds, game mammals, and furbearing mammals protected by Indiana law.

Effective: July 1, 2014.

# **SENATE BILL No. 361**

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning natural and cultural resources.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1	SECTION 1. IC 14-22-20-1 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
2	FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2014]: Sec. 1. (a) The department
3	may, under rules adopted under IC 4-22-2, issue to a resident of
4	Indiana, upon the payment of a fee of fifteen dollars (\$15), a license to:
5	(1) propagate in captivity, and (2) possess, buy, or sell, for this
6	purpose purposes of this section only, game birds, game
7	mammals, or furbearing mammals protected by Indiana law;
8	(2) train dogs, inside game breeder enclosures, to track game
9	birds, game mammals, and furbearing mammals described in
0	subdivision (1); and
1	(3) conduct, inside game breeder enclosures, field trials of
2	dogs trained to track game birds, game mammals, and
3	furbearing mammals described in subdivision (1).
4	(b) This section does not authorize the use of dogs in pursuit of
5	game birds, game mammals, or furbearing mammals protected by
6	Indiana law for the express purpose of taking, hunting, catching,

- or killing inside of game breeder enclosures approved by the department.
