DIGEST OF SB 364 (Updated February 15, 2016 10:24 am - DI 84)

Citations Affected: Noncode.

Synopsis: Medicaid provider audit work group. Requires the office of Medicaid policy and planning (office) to establish a work group to discuss the policies and procedures used in Medicaid provider audits. Requires the office to submit the work group's findings and any statutory recommendations to legislative council before December 1, 2016.

Effective: Upon passage.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:
