## **SENATE BILL No. 380**

## DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

**Citations Affected:** IC 20-26-13-5; IC 20-33-8-8.

**Synopsis:** Various education matters. Amends the definition of "graduation" for purposes of the high school graduation rate determination. Allows a school corporation to adopt a policy concerning dress code or disruptive behavior.

Effective: July 1, 2023.

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning education.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

2	(b) The term does not include the granting of a general educational
