# **SENATE BILL No. 403**

DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 9-21-12-20.

**Synopsis:** School bus route safety. Provides that the governing body of a public or accredited nonpublic elementary school may not authorize a school bus driver to load or unload a student at a location that requires the student to cross a roadway if the roadway: (1) is a U.S. route or state route; or (2) has a speed limit that exceeds 50 miles per hour. Provides that a governing body may request a waiver for a particular stop for a period not to exceed one year by submitting a request to the state school bus committee.

Effective: July 1, 2019.

### SENATE BILL No. 403

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning education.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:* 

SECTION 1. IC 9-21-12-20 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE AS A NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2019]: Sec. 20. (a) The governing body of a public or accredited nonpublic elementary school (as defined by IC 20-18-2-4) may not authorize a school bus driver to load or unload a student at a location that requires the student to cross a roadway if the roadway:

(1) is a U.S. route or state route; or

(2) has a speed limit that exceeds fifty (50) miles per hour.

10 (b) The governing body of a public or accredited nonpublic elementary school (as defined in IC 20-18-2-4) may request a 12 waiver for a particular school bus stop, for a period not to exceed 13 one (1) year, from the requirements described in subsection (a) by 14 submitting a request to the state school bus committee established 15 by IC 20-27-3-1 in a manner prescribed by the state school bus 16 committee. The state school bus committee may grant a waiver 17 under this subsection if:
