COMMITTEE REPORT

Madam President: The Senate Committee on Local Government, to which was referred Senate Bill No. 405, has had the same under consideration and begs leave to report the same back to the Senate with the recommendation that said bill be AMENDED as follows:

Delete the title and insert the following:

A BILL FOR AN ACT concerning local government.

Page 1, delete lines 1 through 15.

Delete pages 2 through 27.

Page 28, delete lines 1 through 33, begin a new paragraph and insert:

"SECTION 1. [EFFECTIVE UPON PASSAGE] (a) As used in this SECTION, "committee" refers to the interim study committee on fiscal policy established by IC 2-5-1.3-4(17).

(b) The legislative council is urged to assign to the committee the task of studying, during the 2021 legislative interim, the creation of wastewater facility improvement districts to capture incremental property tax revenue to be used to connect properties in the district to a municipal sewer system.

(c) If the legislative council assigns the topic under subsection (a), the study must include consideration of the following:

(1) An examination of how tax revenue is used.

(2) The criteria for drawing district boundaries.

(3) The selection criteria for inclusion of properties selected in the district, including properties already connected to the municipal sewer system.

(d) This SECTION expires January 1, 2022."

Re-number all SECTIONS consecutively.
