DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 10-18-1-20; IC 10-18-1-29.

Synopsis: Indiana War Memorials. Provides for the Indiana War Memorials Commission (commission) to adopt rules that allow for the consumption and possession of alcoholic beverages in or on memorial facility property under certain circumstances. Allows the commission to adopt rules concerning: (1) terms and conditions under which a military veteran or a military veteran's spouse may use a memorial facility for funeral purposes; (2) terms and conditions under which an admission fee may be charged for entrance into a memorial facility; (3) terms and conditions under which any solicitation, ticket sales, or commercial activity may occur on the premises or in a memorial facility; (4) terms and conditions under which the commission may accept gifts and loans of artifacts or historic property; and (5) a policy concerning skateboarding on the premises of a memorial facility. Allows the commission to adopt emergency rules to comply with this provision. Voids an administrative rule prohibiting admission fees.

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning military and veterans.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

- (c) The commission may adopt rules under IC 4-22-2 that set forth the following:
 - (1) The terms and conditions during which a person may possess or consume an alcoholic beverage in or on the premises of a memorial facility. If a rule is adopted under this subdivision, a sign that states alcoholic beverages are not permitted must be posted in the area where alcoholic beverages are not permitted.
 - (2) The terms and conditions under which a military veteran

3	(3) The terms and conditions under which an admission fee
4	may be charged for entering a memorial facility. However, a
5	person who is on active duty (as defined in IC 25-1-12-2) may
