DIGEST OF SB 416 (Updated March 20, 2019 7:36 pm - DI 77)

Citations Affected: IC 12-15.

Synopsis: Medicaid coverage for doula services. Provides that Medicaid pregnancy services may include reimbursement for doula services.

Effective: July 1, 2019.

ENGROSSED SENATE BILL No. 416

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning Medicaid.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1	SECTION 1. IC 12-15-5-7 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
2	AS A NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY
3	1, 2019]: Sec. 7. (a) Pregnancy services provided under this article
4	may include reimbursement for doula services.
5	(b) The office may apply for any state plan amendment or
5	waiver necessary to implement this section.

(c) The office may adopt rules under IC 4-22-2 to implement this section.
