SENATE BILL No. 492

A BILL FOR AN ACT concerning military and veterans and to make an appropriation.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

SECTION 1. [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2019] (a) There is
appropriated from the state general fund to the Indiana
department of veterans' affairs for the period beginning July 1
2019, and ending June 30, 2021, six hundred thousand dollars
(\$600,000) for the purpose of establishing, operating, and
maintaining a veterans cemetery at Oak Hill Cemetery in
Evansville.

(b) This SECTION expires June 30, 2021.
