

SENATE BILL No. 506

DIGEST OF SB 506 (Updated February 21, 2017 2:33 pm - DI 104)

Citations Affected: IC 12-21; IC 16-31; IC 20-26; IC 21-48.

Synopsis: Suicide prevention programming. Requires the division of mental health and addiction to: (1) develop a statewide program for suicide prevention; and (2) employ a coordinator of the statewide program for suicide prevention. Requires the coordinator to study and determine: (1) the professions that should be required to receive training on suicide assessment, treatment, and management; and (2) the manner in which to fund the training. Requires the coordinator to report the determinations to the legislative council not later than December 31, 2017. Requires emergency medical services providers to complete an evidence based training program concerning suicide assessment, treatment, and management. Requires a school corporation to adopt a policy addressing measures intended to increase child suicide awareness and sets forth requirements of policy. Requires approved postsecondary educational institutions to adopt a policy concerning suicide information and resources.

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning human services.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

28	adopt a policy addressing measures intended to increase child
29	suicide awareness and prevention. The policy must address the

33	(2) Availability of referral information for crisis intervention
34	to children, parents, and school corporation staff.

16	national, state, and local suicide prevention hotlines;
17	(2) available mental health programs;
