

## SENATE BILL No. 529

DIGEST OF SB 529 (Updated February 18, 2019 11:29 am - DI 129)

Citations Affected: IC 14-24.

**Synopsis:** Beekeeping. Provides that a county, city, town, or township shall not adopt or continue in effect any ordinance, rule, regulation, or resolution prohibiting the establishment or maintenance of honeybees and hives.

Effective: July 1, 2019.

## **SENATE BILL No. 529**

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning natural and cultural resources.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

(b) This section shall not be construed to restrict the zoning authority of a unit (as defined in IC 36-1-2-23) regarding honeybees and hives.

Madam President: The Senate Committee on Agriculture, to which was referred Senate Bill No. 529, has had the same under consideration and begs leave to report the same back to the Senate with the recommendation that said bill be AMENDED as follows:

Page 1, delete lines 1 through 8, begin a new paragraph and insert: "SECTION 1. IC 14-24-8-0.5 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE AS A NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2019]: Sec. 0.5. (a) Except as provided in subsection (b) and notwithstanding any other law, a unit (as defined in IC 36-1-2-23) shall not adopt or continue in effect any ordinance, rule, regulation, or resolution prohibiting the establishment or maintenance of honeybees and hives.

(b) This section shall not be construed to restrict the zoning authority of a unit (as defined in IC 36-1-2-23) regarding honeybees and hives.".
