DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 20-28-5.

Synopsis: Teacher licensing examinations. Requires, not later than July 1, 2020, the state board of education to adopt teacher licensing examinations to replace the teacher licensing examinations administered on July 1, 2019. Requires, not later than July 1, 2021, the department of education to implement the adopted teacher licensing examinations.

Effective: July 1, 2019.
