DIGEST OF SB 547 (Updated February 20, 2019 3:11 pm - DI 110)

Citations Affected: Noncode.

Synopsis: Study of education matters. Urges the legislative council to assign to an appropriate study committee the topics of: (1) improving science education; (2) improving mathematics, geography, and personal finance education in kindergarten through grade 12; and (3) including entrepreneurship curriculum in kindergarten through grade 12

Effective: Upon passage.

Delete pages 2 through 5.

Page 6, delete lines 1 through 6.

Page 6, line 7, delete "[EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2019]" and insert "[EFFECTIVE UPON PASSAGE]".

Page 6, line 9, delete "the topic of improving science" and insert "the following topics:

- (1) Improving science education in kindergarten through grade 12, including the following issues:
 - (A) Whether scientific disciplines, such as chemistry, physics, and biology, should be taught on a stand alone basis.
 - (B) Whether science instruction could be organized at all grade levels such that fundamental concepts in each scientific discipline are taught in proper sequential order to enhance a deeper understanding of subject matters.
 - (C) Any other issue the committee considers relevant to the subject of improving science education.
- (2) Improving mathematics, geography, and personal finance education in kindergarten through grade 12.
- (3) Including entrepreneurship curriculum in kindergarten through grade 12.".

Page 6, delete lines 10 through 19.

Page 6, line 21, delete "topic" and insert "topics".

Page 6, line 22, delete "topic" and insert "topics".



Page 6, after line 24, begin a new paragraph and insert: "SECTION 2. **An emergency is declared for this act."**. Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
