1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION directing the Congress of
2 the United States to propose to the several states an amendment
3 to the United States Constitution concerning the membership of
4 the United States Supreme Court.

5 *Whereas, Several Joint Resolutions have been proposed in the*
6 *117th Congress to amend the United States Constitution to*
7 *provide that the United States Supreme Court consist of not*
8 *more than nine (9) members;*

9 *Whereas, The Indiana General Assembly agrees with the*
10 *intent of these Joint Resolutions; and*

11 *Whereas, The Indiana General Assembly supports the*
12 *adoption and submission of such an amendment to the several*
13 *states for ratification: Therefore,*

14 *Be it resolved by the Senate*
15 *of the General Assembly of the State of Indiana,*
16 *the House of Representatives concurring:*

17 SECTION 1. That the Congress of the United States is
18 directed to propose to the states the following amendment to the
19 United States Constitution:

20 "The Supreme Court of the United States shall be
21 composed of nine Justices."

22 SECTION 2. That certified copies of this resolution be sent
23 to each of the following:

24 (1) The presiding officers of the Congress of the United
25 States.

26 (2) The Secretary of the Senate.
