3	Whereas, Paul Loggan passed away on April 12, 2020;
4	Whereas, Paul Loggan was born on April 5, 1963, in
5	Shelbyville, Indiana, to Marjorie and William Loggan Jr.;
6	Whereas, Paul excelled in athletics from a young age, and
7	after graduating from Rushville High School in 1981, Paul was
8	an All-American linebacker and team captain for the football
9	team at the University of Indianapolis;
10	Whereas, After graduating from the University of
11	Indianapolis in 1985, Paul received his master's degree from
12	Ball State University;
13	Whereas, Paul began his career student teaching at
14	Franklin Central High School, taught at Roncalli High School
15	for two years, and then in 1988 became a Panther and worked
16	for the remainder of his career at North Central High School;
17	Whereas, While at North Central High School, Paul
18	coached wrestling and football, was a strength coach, a health
19	and physical education teacher, an assistant athletic director,
20	and the athletic director of North Central High School;
21	Whereas, Paul paid special attention to all of his athletes,
22	and during his time as North Central High School's assistant



athletic director and athletic director, he presided over an impressive thirty-three state championships;

Whereas, Throughout his years of coaching at North Central High School, Paul coached six future NFL players, including two Super Bowl winners, and thousands of other incredible individuals whose lives were shaped by Paul's passion and devotion;

Whereas, Paul was the past President of the Indiana Football Coaches Association, board member of the Indiana Athletic Directors Association, member of the Indiana Interscholastic Athletic Administrators Association, was the Game Director for the Indiana North South All Star Football Game for almost thirty years, and was inducted into the UIndy Hall of Fame in 2012;

Whereas, Paul valued his family more than anything, and it was a rare sight to see him without at least one of his three children, Michael, Will, or Sami, or his wife of nearly twentynine years, Kathy (Sahm) Loggan, by his side;

Whereas, A mentor and friend to all, Paul consistently went above and beyond for those around him, often welcoming his players who were hungry or needed a place to stay into his own home, and although he was tough on his players, he was the first to say "I love you" to them without hesitation;

Whereas, A fierce but gracious competitor, Paul will be remembered for his genuine wisdom, unconditional love, and fun memories such as him coaching in shorts in freezing weather or doing cartwheels to entertain those around him, as his dynamic personality was truly one of a kind; and

Whereas, A devoted athlete, coach, friend, father, and husband, Paul's passing is deeply mourned and his compassionate spirit will be missed by the thousands of athletes that he was a father figure to, his wife Kathy, his children Will, Sami, and Michael (fiancée Megan Sizemore), his mother Marjorie, his brothers Bo and Ted (wife Gena), his sister Kelly,
