2	Scott Robison on his retirement and honoring his thirty-eight
3	years of dedicated service to Indiana's schools.
4	Whereas, Dr. Scott Robison is retiring after four decades
5	of faithfully serving Indiana's schools and young Hoosiers;
6	Whereas, Dr. Robison received his undergraduate degree
7	and master's degree from Indiana University, after which he
8	completed his doctorate at Purdue University;
9	Whereas, Dr. Robison began his career in education as a
10	teacher in the New Albany-Floyd County Schools, where he
11	was raised;
12	Whereas, After leaving New Albany-Floyd County, Dr.
13	Robison briefly worked as a media relations and inventory
14	manager, then as an alumni association administrator at
15	Indiana University before returning to a career as an educator;
16	Whereas, Dr. Robison served in central office roles in
17	finance and curriculum in the Westfield school system, then as
18	a teacher and principal at the Metropolitan School District of
19	Pike Township for eleven years, and as a principal in the
20	Southwest Allen County School District in Fort Wayne;
21	Whereas, In 2006, Dr. Robison was named superintendent
22	of Zionsville Community Schools, a position he served with
23	distinction for the last sixteen years;



Whereas, During his tenure as superintendent, Dr. Robison 1 embraced a philosophy of collaboration and teambuilding, 2 fostering a community of educators, staff, and parents who 3 cooperated in facilitating the development of their students, 4 5 illustrated by the Zionsville Community School District's persistent growth and its placement among the top five 6 *highest-performing districts in the state;* 7 Whereas, Dr. Robison was named the Indiana School 8 9 Boards Association's 2022 Educator of the Year and was the recipient of the Lorin A. Burt Outstanding Educator Award in 10 the same year for his academic excellence, financial 11 stewardship, and attention to personal relationships; and 12 13 Whereas, The Indiana General Assembly is grateful that Dr. Robison dedicated his professional life to serving his 14 community and the education of Indiana's children, sharing his 15 wisdom and contagious kindness with all fortunate to work and 16 17 learn under his tutelage, and wishes him well as he embarks on this new journey: Therefore, 18 Be it resolved by the Senate of the General Assembly 19 of the State of Indiana, the House of Representatives 20 concurring: 21 SECTION 1.
