3 *Whereas, Jim Clark passed away on February 14, 2021, at*
4 *the age of 91 years old;*

5 *Whereas, Jim was born on April 13, 1929, in Indianapolis,*
6 *Indiana, to Alexander and Ida Clark;*

7 *Whereas, After graduating from Wabash College in 1951,*
8 *Jim joined the United States Marine Corps, where he served*
9 *with honor and distinction in the Korean War in an amphibious*
10 *tank division, and after being honorably discharged as a*
11 *Lieutenant, Jim continued to serve as a Captain in the United*
12 *States Marine Corps Reserve;*

13 *Whereas, After graduating from Indiana University Law*
14 *School in Bloomington in 1957, Jim began a distinguished*
15 *career in the practice of law at the law firm now known as*
16 *Clark, Quinn, Moses, Scott & Grahn, and later was elected as*
17 *a Distinguished Fellow of the Indianapolis Bar Foundation in*
18 *1985;*

19 *Whereas, Committed to living a life of public service, Jim*
20 *served in the Indiana House of Representatives from 1962 to*
21 *1964, and was honored with three Sagamores of the Wabash*
22 *from Governors Harold Handley, Matthew Welsh, and Mitch*
23 *Daniels;*

24 *Whereas, Jim was involved in a number of organizations*



1 *throughout Indianapolis, serving as a past president and*
 2 *member of the Hundred Club and the Columbia Club; a board*
 3 *member of the Indianapolis Metropolitan Police Department*
 4 *Motorcycle Drill Team, Brebeuf Jesuit Preparatory School, and*
 5 *St. Vincent's Hospital Foundation; a past commander and life*
 6 *member of the American Legion Post 34; and a member of the*
 7 *American Business Club, the Antelope Club, the Indianapolis*
 8 *Oldtimers, the 702 Club, and the Scottish Rite;*

9 *Whereas, Jim is survived by his wife Claire, his children,*
 10 *Murray, Matt, Cameron, and Heather, his grandchildren,*
 11 *Jimmy, Holly, Bobby, Kate, Megan, Lilly, Adam, Annie, Luke,*
 12 *and Collin, and his great-grandson, Teddy; and*

13 *Whereas, Jim Clark will be remembered for his passion for*
 14 *public service, his love of family, and his commitment to the*
 15 *strong Hoosier values of honor, honesty, loyalty, respect for*
 16 *others, and the importance of hard work: Therefore,*

17 *Be it resolved by the Senate of the General Assembly*
 18 *of the State of Indiana, the House of Representatives*
 19 *concurring:*

 21 memorializes James C. Clark.
