13	Whereas, The CYH program fields eight different travel
14	teams, collectively known as the Columbus Flames, for players
15	between the ages of five and fifteen;
16	Whereas, The Columbus Flames have achieved their own
17	success, including a state championship by the 14U team and
18	a state finals appearance by one of the 10U teams;
19	Whereas, Many of the players in the CYH program have the
20	goal to play for the Icemen when they reach high school;
21	Whereas, The 2021 Icemen hockey team consists of
22	teammates Alex Clark, Jacob McMullen, Jack Warble,
23	Cameron Stattenfield, Barrett Mudd, Caleb McGhehey, Evan

4	Whereas, In the state tournament, the Icemen, coached by
5	Isaac Coy, defeated the Carrol Chargers by a score of 4-2, and
6	then proceeded to shut out the Riley Wildcats, 2-0, through
7	smart offense, aggressive defense, and skillful play in the net by
8	the Icemen goalie, and later beat the Leo Lions by a score of 1
9	0;
10	Whereas, The Icemen captured the ISHSHA Class 2A
11	championship by defeating the Central Indiana Knights by a
12	score of 4-2, with Andrew Clark, John Ferguson, Joe Neal, and
13	Brayson Bennett each scoring one goal for the Icemen, two
14	assists from Evan Federle, one assist from John Ferguson, and
15	goalie Jacob McMullen stopping 21 of 23 shots; and
