2	of Lester J. "Les" Fox.
3	Whereas, Lester J. "Les" Fox was born on August 8, 1924,
4	in Chilton, Wisconsin to John and Lillian (Bowe) Fox;
5	Whereas, Les served in the United States Navy during
6	World War II and, upon his return from the war, married the
7	love of his life, Viola Kurtz, on July 19, 1949;
8	Whereas, Les was an integral member of the South Bend
9	community, working for the Studebaker Corporation from 1944
10	to 1963 as a dedicated employee and eventual vice president of
11	Local #5 of the International Union of United Automobile
12	Workers;
13	Whereas, After his tenure at Studebaker Corporation, Les
14	became nationally involved in fighting for the rights of the
15	unemployed, the elderly, and the underserved by becoming the
16	director for Project ABLE in 1963, establishing the Regional
17	Office of Economic Opportunity in Atlanta, Georgia to
18	implement the Economic Opportunity Act under President
19	Lyndon Johnson, and then becoming the President and CEO of
20	REAL Services, Inc. in South Bend;

21 Whereas, During his time at REAL Services, Inc., Les 22 testified before Congress to urge passage of the Older

1 Americans Act;

2 Whereas, Under Les's leadership, REAL Services, Inc. was designated as the Area Agency on Aging and served older 3 4 adults in five different Indiana counties; Whereas, Les served on numerous Advisory Councils and 5 Boards throughout Indiana, including a role as Program 6 7 Consultant to the U.S. Department of Labor, U.S. Senate 8 Committee on Aging, and the National Council on Aging; 9 Whereas, Les received the Sagamore of the Wabash from Governors Orr, Bayh, O'Bannon, Kernan, and Daniels and was 10 inducted into the South Bend Community Hall of Fame in 1996; 11 Whereas, Les retired as President and CEO of REAL 12 Services, Inc. at the age of 82 on March 1, 2007, to enjoy 13 friends and the game of golf; and 14 Whereas, Les passed away on October 11, 2016, at the age 15 of 92, leaving a legacy as a trailblazer and a highly respected 16 advocate for underserved populations in his community: 17 Therefore, 18 Be it resolved by the Senate of the General Assembly 19 20 of the State of Indiana, the House of Representatives concurring: SECTION 1. That the Indiana General Assembly memorializes the 21 life of Lester J. "Les" Fox. 22 SECTION 2.
