11	more than 945,000 members and 9,150 chapters, while Indiana
12	FFA membership has grown to more than 14,000 members and
13	228 chapters;
14	Whereas, Both organizations have become dynamic youth
15	bodies with a mission to change lives and prepare members for
16	premier leadership, personal growth, and career success
17	through agricultural education;
18	Whereas, FFA accomplishes this mission by developing
19	agricultural leaders, increasing awareness of the importance
20	of agriculture, strengthening the confidence of students
21	involved, promoting the choice of agriculture as a career,
22	encouraging agricultural experience programs, highlighting
23	wise management of community resources, developing
24	members' interpersonal skills and character, promoting
