5	Whereas, New Palestine's softball team, the Dragons,
6	finished the 2017 season with a twenty-two game win streak
0 7	with a total of thirty-one wins and two losses;
0	When the Durant musical resident Harmon
8	Whereas, The Dragons prevailed against Herron,
9	Indianapolis Bishop Chatard, Brebeuf Jesuit Preparatory,
10	Lebanon, Edgewood, and Evansville Memorial High School
11	to play against Kankakee Valley High School in the state
12	championship game located at Ben Davis High School;
13	Whereas, The Dragons set a state record of fifty-seven
14	home runs in a season through thirty-three games including
15	twenty-eight times where at least one ball left the yard during
16	a single game;
17	Whereas, The Dragons obtained state records of 465 hits
18	and 383 runs in a single season with an average of eleven
19	runs per game, which included twenty-one home runs from
20	junior Ashley Prange, who ended the season with a state
21	record of 67 RBIs;
22	Whereas, Senior Elisha Barker pitched a complete game
23	with four strikeouts for her twenty-second win of the year and

24 was named the IHSAA's Class 3A Mental Attitude Award

Whereas, New Palestine made thirteen runs in the 2 championship game including a two run single by senior 3 Abigail Davis in the second inning, eight runs on seven hits 4 5 in the fourth inning including a score by freshman Michaela Jones on a throwing error, a three-run home run by Ashley 6 Prange, a run through a sacrifice fly from sophomore Tatum 7 8 Biddle, and run-scoring hits by senior Madison Whitaker and Elisha Barker, as well as one run in the fifth inning and two 9 10 runs on the top of the seventh inning;

Whereas, Nine Dragons recorded at least one hit with
five extra-base hits during the championship game including
two doubles from senior Mary Crumlin, who tied a Class 3A
championship record;

Whereas, The Dragons made numerous Class 3A state finals game records including seventeen hits, thirteen runs, and ten RBIs, while also tying a Class 3A record of seven hits during a single inning and issuing a combined Class 3A title game record of most combined hits and most combined runs with twenty-nine and nineteen respectively;

Whereas, This is the fourth championship for coach Ed
Marcum who led the Dragons to titles in 2004 and 2008 and
holds a record of 357-58 over his fourteen seasons at New
Palestine; and

Whereas, New Palestine softball achieved its fourth state
championship in school history with a final score of 13-6
against Kankakee Valley High School: Therefore,
