13	and the current chair of the Governor's Workforce Cabinet;

15	Commissioner Lubbers has always recognized the centrality of
16	education to a full, thriving life, so during her tenure on the
17	Commission, Commissioner Lubbers has worked tirelessly to
18	increase college completion, ensure academic quality and
19	student learning, and align postsecondary credentials with
20	meaningful careers;
