1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION honoring the Indiana
2 University Jacobs School of Music on the occasion of its 100th
3 anniversary.

4 *Whereas, The School of Music has grown from a*
5 *Department of Music initially established in 1907 to the largest*
6 *school of music in the world;*

8 *Whereas, The Indiana University Jacobs School of Music*
9 *was established as a School on on March 21, 1921 by an act of*
10 *the Indiana University Board of Trustees;*

11 *Whereas, The IU Jacobs School of Music has developed*
12 *and continues its leadership and excellence in musical*
13 *education through more than 170 full-time, internationally*
14 *celebrated faculty, state-of-the-art learning and performance*
15 *facilities, and more than 70 academic programs ranging from*
16 *undergraduate to Ph.D.;*

17 *Whereas, The Jacobs School maintains its position as one*
18 *of the leading institutions for the comprehensive study of music*
19 *and dance by offering a conservatory-based education in the*
20 *context of a flagship public research institution, which expands*
21 *student experience and development, as well as opportunities*
22 *for interdisciplinary growth;*

23 *Whereas, Nearly 1,600 students from all 50 states as well*
24 *as 56 countries study at Jacobs, benefitting from the intensity*



1 *and focus of a conservatory setting combined with the broad*
2 *academic offerings of a major research university;*

4 *Whereas, The Jacobs School's alumni can be found in*
5 *major institutions for the study of music, as well as in every*
6 *single major orchestra throughout the world;*

7 *Whereas, The Jacobs School has been ranked the number*
8 *one music school in America by Change Magazine, the*
9 *Chronicle of Higher Education and U.S. News and World*
10 *Report;*

12 *Whereas, The Jacobs School has counted among its faculty*
13 *acclaimed international artists, such as violinists Josef*
14 *Gingold, Alexander Kerr, and Simin Ganatra, cellists Janos*
15 *Starker and Eric Kim, pianists Menahem Pressler and Norman*
16 *Krieger, ballet masters Violette Verdy and Kyra Nichols, tubists*
17 *Harvey Phillips and Daniel Perantoni, vocalists Camilla*
18 *Williams, James King, Sylvia McNair, Tim Noble, Virginia*
19 *Zenni, and Marietta Simpson and Indianapolis jazz musician*
20 *David Baker;*

21 *Whereas, The Indiana University Jacobs School of Music*
22 *Opera Theater is internationally recognized, having a global*
23 *reach thanks to its live streaming capabilities and has the most*
24 *extensive performance schedule of any opera company outside*
25 *of New York's Metropolitan Opera;*

26 *Whereas, The faculty and students give more than 1100*
27 *performances every year, all of them open to the public and the*
28 *vast majority of them free;*

29 *Whereas, The Jacobs School maintains six full separate and*
30 *distinct symphony orchestras each of which performs numerous*
31 *times throughout the school year; and*

32 *Whereas, A \$40.6 million dollar gift from late Indiana*
33 *University alumni, Barbara B. and David H. Jacobs, Sr.*
34 *resulted in the renaming of the School as the "Indiana*
35 *University Jacobs School of Music," and has helped position*



1 *the School as one of the preeminent academic institutions for*
2 *the study of music: Therefore,*

3 *Be it resolved by the Senate of the General Assembly*
4 *of the State of Indiana, the House of Representatives*
5 *concurring:*

6 SECTION 1. That the General Assembly honors and
7 congratulates the Indiana University Jacobs School of Music on
8 the occasion of the 100th anniversary of its establishment.

9 SECTION 2. That the Secretary of the Senate is hereby
10 directed to transmit copies of this Resolution to the Board of
11 Trustees of Indiana University and to the Dean of the Indiana
12 University Jacobs School of Music.
