Whereas, On December 8, 2021, the Fishers High School
"We the People" team won the 2021 "We the People" State
Finals in Indianapolis, Indiana, by defeating teams from 11
high schools in order to represent Indiana in the 2022 "We the
People" National Finals;

9 Whereas, During the annual civics competition, more than 10 500 middle and high school students from across the state 11 prepared statements and answered questions from panels of 12 judges concerning the United States Constitution and its 13 application to relevant historical and contemporary issues;

Whereas, The "We the People" National Finals took place
from April 22-25, 2022, consisting of more than 636 half-hour
virtual hearings, where approximately 1,000 students in 47
classes from across the United States showcased their depth
and breadth of knowledge of our nation's founding documents
through simulated legislative hearings;

Whereas, Over the competition, Fishers High School students studied and offered 18 different presentations about constitutional issues, demonstrating their understanding of various topics ranging from constitutional philosophical foundations, the Constitutional Convention, structure and function of government, Bill of Rights protections, and citizenship; and
