1           A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION honoring Jack E. Schult on the  
2 occasion of his retirement.

3           *Whereas, Jack E. Schult graduated from Jefferson High*  
4 *School in Lafayette, Indiana, and received his B.S. and M.S.*  
5 *in Secondary Administration and Supervision from Purdue*  
6 *University;*

7           *Whereas, Jack's career with Lafayette School*  
8 *Corporation spanned a duration of more than fifty years,*  
9 *during which time he served his community as a teacher,*  
10 *administrator, and coach;*

11           *Whereas, As both an assistant and head coach, Jack was*  
12 *instrumental in Jefferson High School achieving the third*  
13 *highest number of sectional championships and the state*  
14 *record for 29 consecutive sectional championships;*

15           *Whereas, During his 52 years in the Lafayette School*  
16 *Corporation, Jack was the head coach of the junior varsity*  
17 *football team for nine years, the junior varsity basketball*  
18 *team for nine years, the junior varsity baseball team for four*  
19 *years, the varsity tennis team for three years, and the varsity*  
20 *basketball team for two years. He was also the assistant*  
21 *coach of the varsity basketball team for sixteen years;*



1           *Whereas, In addition, Jack was the Assistant Athletic*  
2           *Director of Jefferson High School from 1980 until 1999;*

3           *Whereas, During his many years coaching at Jefferson*  
4           *High School, Jack never had a losing season;*

5           *Whereas, As a coach at Jefferson High School, Jack has*  
6           *received four state championship rings: one as head coach*  
7           *of the 1975 state champion tennis team, one as assistant*  
8           *coach of the 1964 state champion basketball team, one as*  
9           *assistant coach of the 1973 state champion baseball team,*  
10           *and one as assistant coach of the 1967 state runner-up*  
11           *basketball team. He also was the assistant coach of the 1969*  
12           *Jefferson High School state champion baseball team;*

13           *Whereas, Jack has received various honors for his*  
14           *excellence in coaching. He was named the North Central*  
15           *Conference Tennis Coach of the Year in 1975 and*  
16           *1976, inducted into the Jefferson High School Hall of Fame*  
17           *in 2013, and inducted into the Indiana Tennis Hall of Fame*  
18           *in 1985;*

19           *Whereas, In addition to coaching in real life, Jack played*  
20           *the role of a basketball coach in the classic film "Hoosiers,"*  
21           *which was filmed in Indiana between the years 1981 and*  
22           *1987. He also played the role of a baseball coach in the film*  
23           *"Eight Men Out";*

24           *Whereas, Jack's love of coaching developed at a young*  
25           *age. He began coaching basketball at St. Ann's in 1956 while*  
26           *he was still in high school, and coached the Central Catholic*  
27           *High School junior varsity basketball team and varsity*  
28           *football team for three years while he was a student at*  
29           *Purdue University;*

30           *Whereas, Jack has written articles on basketball drills*  
31           *published in Scholastic Coach magazine, he has served as*  
32           *program director and lecturer at Indiana State Basketball*  
33           *Clinic, and he has served on the Board of Directors of the*



1 *Indiana Basketball Coaches Association and the Indiana*  
2 *Tennis Coaches Association;*

3 *Whereas, Jack retired from his career with Lafayette*  
4 *School Corporation in 2016, and his enthusiasm and*  
5 *dedication to coaching will be greatly missed; and*

6 *Whereas, It is fitting that the Indiana General Assembly*  
7 *honors Jack E. Schult on the occasion of his retirement,*  
8 *thanks him for his many years of service to Indiana scholar-*  
9 *athletes in his community, and wishes him health and*  
10 *happiness in the years to come: Therefore,*

11 *Be it resolved by the Senate of the General Assembly*  
12 *of the State of Indiana, the House of Representatives concurring:*

13 SECTION 1. That the Indiana General Assembly honors  
14 Jack E. Schult on the occasion of his retirement, thanks him for  
15 his dedication to coaching and teaching students in his  
16 community, and wishes him health and happiness in the years  
17 to come.
