6	football team, the Panthers, completed the 2017 season with
7	fifteen wins and zero losses;
8	Whereas, The Panthers competed against Carroll, North
9	White, Lafayette Central Catholic, LaVille, and Monroe
10	Central High Schools to play against Eastern Greene High
11	School in the IHSAA Class A state championship game at
12	Lucas Oil Stadium;
13	Whereas, Junior quarterback Jack Kiser completed two
14	2-yard rushing touchdowns in the first and second quarter to
15	put the panthers ahead of Eastern Green 14-7;
16	Whereas, Sophomore running back Miles VonToble
17	caught a 10-yard pass from Jack Kiser and fought a defender
18	to the end zone for a touchdown with 1:50 left in the second
19	quarter;
20	Whereas, Jack Kiser broke away from two defenders to
21	throw an 18-yard touchdown pass to freshman running back
22	Ezra Lewellen with 0:05 left in the second quarter to
23	complete the first half of the championship game with a score

1	Whereas, Jack Kiser broke through a hole in the line of
2	scrimmage to sprint 53 yards for a rushing touchdown with
3	2:59 left in the third quarter;
4	Whereas, Junior fullback Daniel Gregorich broke
5	through a tight break in the line of scrimmage to run for a
6	30-yard touchdown with 3:33 left in the fourth quarter;
7	Whereas, Senior kicker Matthew Musbaum made all six
8	extra point attempts during the championship game;
9	Whereas, The Panther defense completed 53 solo tackles,
10	26 assists, 5 tackles for a loss, and 3.5 sacks;
11	Whereas, The Panthers won the Class A championship
12	game with a final score of 42-14 after scoring on six of their
13	eight drives of the day;
14	Whereas, Senior offensive lineman Garrett Schroder was
15	named the winner of the Blake Ress Mental Attitude Award
16	for Class A for demonstrating the best mental attitude,
17	scholarship, leadership, and athletic ability; and
18	Whereas, This is the third state championship game in
19	the last four years, the second overall football state
20	championship title, and the first championship title since
21	1997 for the Pioneer Junior-Senior High School football
