3	Whereas, The Indiana State Bar Association Leadership
4	Development Academy (LDA) empowers and develops lawyers
5	to be informed, committed, and involved in order to serve as
6	role models in matters of ethics and professionalism in local
7	and state bar associations, Indiana communities, and
8	organizations;
9	Whereas, The LDA Class of 2019, the eighth annual class
10	of the program, consists of 25 Indiana lawyers who have been
11	admitted to practice law for 15 years or less;
12	Whereas, LDA incorporates professional facilitators and
13	prominent leaders from various disciplines to inform
14	participants about leadership principles and techniques, the
15	importance of effective leaders in organizations and
16	governments for the maximization of efficiency and
17	effectiveness, and the challenges and rewards of leadership in
18	action;
19	Whereas, The LDA class members are selected from around
20	the state and are exposed to topics such as public service,
21	economic development, government, the military, leadership,
22	diversity and inclusion, and other related leadership topics;
23	Whereas, As LDA class members travel around the state,
24	they actively engage in panel discussions, group activities, and
25	demonstrations with faculty who include Indiana Supreme

2	members of the executive and legislative branches of Indiana
3	government, and prominent business and military leaders;
4	Whereas, One of the principal themes of the LDA is
5	"Leadership begins with the attitude of a servant leader - to
6	serve first, and out of service we are given the honor to lead",

8	Whereas, February 18, 2019, and February 19, 2019, mark
9	the LDA session days when focus is placed on local and state
10	government by providing the class the opportunity to ge
11	acquainted with members of the Indiana Supreme Court and
12	Court of Appeals, tour the Indiana Statehouse, the Birch Bayh
13	Federal Building, the United States Courthouse, discuss issues
14	with Indiana legislators, and hear an oral argument.
