1	A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION honoring Corporal
2	Kelsee Lainhart of the United States Marine Corps for her
3	valiant service during the evacuation of the Hamid Karzai
4	International Airport in Kabul, Afghanistan.
5	Whereas, In 2021, the United States began the withdrawal
6	of the 2,500 soldiers that remained in Afghanistan after the
7	nearly 20-year-long war;
8	Whereas, On May 1, 2021, as U.S. forces withdrew, the
9	Taliban began an offensive to topple the Islamic Republic of
10	Afghanistan;
11	Whereas, The Taliban effectively obtained their objective
12	on August 15, 2021, when they seized the presidential palace in
13	Kabul after the elected president fled the country;
14	Whereas, Despite the Taliban takeover, a small pocket of
15	American troops retained control of the Hamid Karzai
16	International Airport in Kabul;
17	Whereas, The troops that remained in the airport were
18	engaged in what is believed to be the largest airlift in American
19	history, evacuating more than 100,000 terrified men, women,
20	and children attempting to flee the Taliban before all U.S.
21	forces left the country on August 31;
22	Whereas, Nineteen-year-old Corporal Kelsee Lainhart from
23	Dearborn County was one of the soldiers assigned to the
24	airport just days before the deadline for withdrawal, and she

1	was focused on the mission to help as many people as she could
2	find freedom from the Taliban;
3	Whereas, On August 26, 2021, a mass of people assembled
4	outside the only open gate to the airport, and they were pushing
5	and straining to get through the gate, some passing out from
6	dehydration and others being crushed by their fellow evacuees;
7	Whereas, Corporal Lainhart was one of the troops helping
8	these desperate people escape, and she remembers helping a
9	small boy get over a wall to his waiting mother;
10	Whereas, At the precise moment Corporal Lainhart was
11	helping the boy, a suicide bomber detonated a 25-pound
12	explosive device concealed under his clothing, sending lethal,
13	5-millimeter ball bearings tearing through the crowd;
14	Whereas, Corporal Lainhart was among the many hit by
15	the shrapnel, suffering severe wounds that included a spinal
16	injury that has left her partially paralyzed;
17	Whereas, The blast killed as many as 170 Afghans and 13
18	American service members, including fellow Hoosier, Corporal
19	Humberto Sanchez, and Corporal Lainhart's close friend,
20	Sergeant Nicole L. Gee;
21	Whereas, Healing from these physical and psychological
22	injuries has been an arduous process and is far from over, but
23	Corporal Lainhart is undaunted and committed to walking
24	again;
25	Whereas, Despite her hardships, Corporal Lainhart does
26	not regret her Marine Corps service, has maintained a positive
27	outlook throughout, and knows that she is one of the lucky
28	ones; and
29	Whereas, The commitment and sacrifice of heroes like
30	Corporal Lainhart should be commemorated and remembered
31	for all time: Therefore,



1	Be it resolved by the Senate of the General Assembly
2	of the State of Indiana, the House of Representatives
3	concurring:
4	SECTION 1. That the Indiana General Assembly honors
5	Corporal Kelsee Lainhart of the United States Marine Corps for
6	her valiant service during the evacuation of the Hamid Karzai
7	International Airport in Kabul, Afghanistan, and wishes her
8	godspeed in her recovery.
9	SECTION 2. The Secretary of the Senate is hereby directed
10	to transmit copies of this Resolution to Corporal Kelsee
11	Lainhart and her family.
