4	Whereas, Cynthia S. Brinker graduated with a Bachelor of
5	Arts in Psychology from DePauw University in 1973;
6	Whereas, Cynthia began working for the University of
7	Southern Indiana in May 1979 as the Director of Human
8	Relations, where she was responsible for the overall
9	development and direction of USI's personnel function and
10	implementation of the Affirmative Action Plan until 1991;
11	Whereas, In 1991, Cynthia began transitioning into
12	university governmental roles including the Assistant Vice
13	President of Business Affairs, Vice President for Government
14	and University Relations, and Chief Legislative Liaison for the
15	University of Southern Indiana, where she represented the
16	interests of the University at the federal, state, and local levels
17	by working closely with members of the Indiana General
18	Assembly, state agencies, and commissions on issues pertaining
19	to higher education;
20	Whereas, Cynthia's responsibilities included preparing
21	biennial operation and capital budget requests, safety and
22	security, human resources, as well as marketing and
23	communicating news and information, web services, special
24	events, publishing services, and alumni and volunteer services;
