1           A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION memorializing the life  
2           and service of Jackie R. Yenna.

3           *Whereas, Jackie "Jack" R. Yenna was born June 1, 1952,*  
4           *in Mishawaka, Indiana;*

5           *Whereas, After graduating from Bloomfield High School,*  
6           *Jack enlisted in the United States Army in 1972, and honorably*  
7           *served until 1977;*

8           *Whereas, For 42 years, Jack worked at General Electric in*  
9           *Bloomington, Indiana, on lines C80 and 81;*

10          *Whereas, Jack proudly served his union family and*  
11          *faithfully represented their interest as Union Shop Steward with*  
12          *IBEW 2249 and President of the White River Central Labor*  
13          *Council, representing affiliated unions and their constituencies*  
14          *in Bartholomew, Brown, Greene, Lawrence, Martin, Monroe,*  
15          *and Owen Counties;*

16          *Whereas, A member of AMVETS and the American Legion*  
17          *in Bloomington, Jack's penchant for advocacy and service to*  
18          *others extended to his fellow veterans, who he helped connect*  
19          *with resources and adjust to life at home;*

20          *Whereas, Devout in his faith, Jack attended the Apostolic*  
21          *Church in Bloomington and regularly committed his time to*  
22          *charitable work;*



1           *Whereas, After a fulfilled life of hard work and service,*  
2           *Jack peacefully passed on January 17, 2023, in the company of*  
3           *his wife, Linda Yenna, and daughter, Terri Freeman;*

4           *Whereas, Jack was laid to rest at Valhalla Memory*  
5           *Gardens with Military Honors, in recognition of his service to*  
6           *a grateful nation; and*

7           *Whereas, Impacting the lives of countless others, Jackie R.*  
8           *Yenna leaves behind a loving family, dear friends, and a legacy*  
9           *characterized by dedication to his community and commitment*  
10           *to his fellow workers and veterans: Therefore,*

11           *Be it resolved by the Senate of the General Assembly*  
12           *of the State of Indiana, the House of Representatives*  
13           *concurring:*

14           SECTION 1. That the Indiana General Assembly  
15           memorializes the life and honors the service of Jackie R.  
16           Yenna.
