10	short time and in the face of great hostility, a free, modern,				
11	and politically stable nation;				
12	Whereas, Israel is a leading contributor in the world

16	Whereas, Indiana and Israel have worked in recent years				
17	to strengthen business and cultural relationships, and Israeli				
18	companies have located in Indiana helping to create Hoosier

3 Be it resolved by the Senate of the General Assembly 4 of the State of Indiana, the House of Representatives concurring:

SECTION 1. That the Indiana General Assembly congratulates and salutes the State of Israel, one of America's most reliable and valuable allies, on the occasion of its 70th Anniversary.

SECTION 2. That the Indiana General Assembly expresses our unwavering commitment to the security and support of a Jewish and democratic State of Israel.

SECTION 3. That the Indiana General Assembly supports on-going work by representatives of the State of Indiana and the State of Israel to continue strengthening economic ties.

SECTION 4. The Secretary of the Senate is hereby directed to transmit a copy of this Resolution to the Consul General of Israel to the Midwest, Aviv Ezra, and to the Israeli Ambassador to the United States, Ron Dermer, as an expression of the General Assembly's admiration for Israel's accomplishments and strength and best wishes for a peaceful and prosperous future.
