4 *Whereas, After earning a bachelor of arts degree in*
5 *journalism from Indiana University and working for several*
6 *years in journalism for Shepard Poorman Communications and*
7 *the Sullivan Daily Times, Teresa Exline found her home at*
8 *Indiana State University (ISU) when she began as the*
9 *Coordinator of Public Affairs in 1987;*

10 *Whereas, Over her 34-year career, Teresa ably served the*
11 *University through a variety of positions, including Director of*
12 *Promotion and Special Events, Executive Director of Public*
13 *Affairs, Assistant Vice President of Communications and*
14 *Marketing, Special Assistant to the President for Strategic*
15 *Communication, and Chief of Staff;*

16 *Whereas, During her tenure at ISU, Teresa worked with*
17 *five of ISU's twelve presidents, including directly and ably*
18 *servng two presidents as Chief of Staff;*

19 *Whereas, Teresa left her mark on many great milestones at*
20 *ISU over the past several decades, including managing the*
21 *University's 125th and 150th anniversary celebrations, the*
22 *Larry Bird Statue dedication and fundraising dinner, and the*
23 *unveiling of the Normal Hall dome as the kickoff to the*
24 *Sesquicentennial;*

25 *Whereas, Teresa has held national leadership positions*



1 *with both the Council for Advancement and Support of*
2 *Education (CASE) and the American Association of State*
3 *Colleges and Universities;*

4 *Whereas, Recognized as a consummate professional, CASE*
5 *District V honored Teresa with the Distinguished Service*
6 *Award and named its Best Practices in Communications and*
7 *Marketing Award in Teresa's honor;*

8 *Whereas, In keeping with ISU's emphasis on community*
9 *service, Teresa was engaged in many local charitable and*
10 *philanthropic efforts, including co-founding 100+ Women Who*
11 *Care Vigo County, working with the Vigo County Historical*
12 *Society, and contributing to the Birthplace of the Coca-Cola*
13 *Bottle Project; and*

14 *Whereas, Teresa will be greatly missed by the faculty,*
15 *students, and alumni, but her tireless devotion to ISU and the*
16 *greater Terre Haute community will not soon be forgotten:*

18 *Be it resolved by the Senate of the General Assembly*
19 *of the State of Indiana, the House of Representatives*
