1	A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION congratulating and honoring
2	Nick Goepper, the bronze medalist in men's slopestyle skiing at the
3	2014 Winter Olympics in Sochi, Russia.
4	Whereas, Nick Goepper was born in Indiana on March 14, 1994,
5	to Chris and Linda Goepper. Nick grew up in the southeastern Indiana
6	city of Lawrenceburg with his parents and three siblings, Kasey,
7	Bradee, and Jason, of whom he is the eldest;
8	Whereas, Nick began skiing at the age of five at Perfect North
9	Slopes in Lawrenceburg, where the tallest hill is only 400 feet high.
10	Since first learning to catch air on his skis, skiing has been Nick's
11	number one passion;
12	Whereas, At the age of eleven, Nick finished 45th out of 47
13	competitors in his first competition. Undaunted, Nick continued
14	pursuing his love, skating on rails and homemade obstacles in his back
15	yard and manufacturing terrain comprised of a mixture of snow and
16	astroturf in order to practice at home;
17	Whereas, In the winters, Nick's father, Chris, would take him to
18	competitions in North Carolina, West Virginia, Missouri, Wisconsin,
19	and Ohio;
20	Whereas, At age fifteen, Nick was awarded a scholarship to
21	Windells Academy in Sandy, Oregon, where he honed his skills on
22	Mount Hood;
23	Whereas, Nick's dedication began paying off and his skills
24	blossomed. Nick made waves on the slopestyle scene in 2012, earning
25	top finishes at multiple events;

1	Whereas, The following year, Nick ascended to the Association of
2	Freeskiing Professionals (AFP) world number one ranking, earning
3	a Winter X Games gold medal and slopestyle AFP title along the way;
4	Whereas, In February of 2014, Nick represented the United States
5	in the XXII Winter Olympic Games in Sochi, Russia, competing in
6	men's slopestyle skiing, which was a Winter Olympic discipline for the
7	first time;
8	Whereas, In the slopestyle finals, Nick successfully landed a triple
9	cork as part of his run that was awarded a score of 92.40, earning him
10	the bronze medal. Nick joined American teammates Joss Christensen
l 1	and Gus Kenworthy on the podium, helping the United States earn only
12	the third podium sweep ever by the United States at a Winter
13	Olympics; and
14	Whereas, Nick's hard work and dedication has set an example for
15	all Hoosiers: Therefore,
16	Be it resolved by the Senate of the General Assembly
17	of the State of Indiana, the House of Representatives concurring:
18	SECTION 1. That the Indiana General Assembly congratulates and
19	honors Nick Goepper for earning the bronze medal in men's slopestyle
20	skiing at the 2014 Winter Olympics in Sochi, Russia.
