2           L. Stevens, M.D.

3           *Whereas, Randall (Randy) L. Stevens was born on March*  
4           *8, 1952, to Dorothy and Jim Stevens;*

5           *Whereas, Shortly after graduating from high school, Dr.*  
6           *Stevens enlisted in the United States Army, where he served as*  
7           *a medical specialist treating American and Vietnamese patients*  
8           *in the 7th Medical Detachment in Qui Nhon, Vietnam, from*  
9           *1971 to 1972;*

10          *Whereas, Dr. Stevens' work as a combat medic in the*  
11          *Central Highlands of Vietnam led him to change his desired*  
12          *career path, starting a 52-year career in the medical field;*

13          *Whereas, Following his discharge from the military, Dr.*  
14          *Stevens went on to receive a bachelor's degree from Duke*  
15          *University in 1977 and a Doctor of Medicine from the Indiana*  
16          *University School of Medicine in 1987;*

17          *Whereas, Upon graduating from medical school and*  
18          *completing residency, Dr. Stevens remained in the Terre Haute*  
19          *community, spending more than 35 years as a local physician*  
20          *at the Union Health Service and the Hamilton Center, and as*  
21          *the Rural Medical Education Program Clinical Professor of*  
22          *Family Medicine at the Indiana University School of Medicine;*

23          *Whereas, Dr. Stevens was instrumental in the development*  
24          *of the Union Hospital Family Medicine Residency's Rural*



1     *Training track, from which 100 physicians have since*  
2     *graduated and located their practice in rural, underserved*  
3     *areas;*

4             *Whereas, Dr. Stevens was a strong proponent of the*  
5     *collaborative care model, embracing Nurse Practitioners and*  
6     *Physician Assistants as vital members of the care continuum,*  
7     *and in doing so, assisted the expansion of the healthcare safety*  
8     *net in the State of Indiana as a whole and the Wabash Valley,*  
9     *in particular;*

10            *Whereas, Over the course of his lifetime, Dr. Stevens was*  
11     *graced with a wide array of honors and awards recognizing his*  
12     *years of service and impact on his colleagues and community,*  
13     *including the prestigious Weinbaum, Chapman S. Root, and the*  
14     *Sagamore of the Wabash awards; and*

15            *Whereas, Dr. Stevens' expertise and influence on his family*  
16     *and friends, the Terre Haute community, and the State of*  
17     *Indiana will be greatly missed: Therefore,*

18            *Be it resolved by the Senate of the General Assembly*  
19            *of the State of Indiana, the House of Representatives*  
20                     *concurring:*

21            SECTION 1. That the Indiana General Assembly  
22     *memorializes Randall L. Stevens, M.D.*
