4 *Whereas, IC 2-2.1-1-3.5 authorizes the General Assembly*
5 *to fix a date for the Second Regular Technical Session of the*
6 *General Assembly;*

7 *Whereas, The General Assembly finds that it is in the best*
8 *interest of the State of Indiana to fix a date for the Technical*
9 *Session; and*

10 *Whereas, It is prudent to allow the President Pro Tempore*
11 *of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives*
12 *to jointly order that the Technical Session not convene if they*
13 *determine the cost and inconvenience do not justify meeting in*
14 *Technical Session: Therefore,*

15 *Be it resolved by the Senate of the General Assembly*
16 *of the State of Indiana, the House of Representatives*
17 *concurring:*

18 SECTION 1. The date for the Second Regular Technical
19 Session of the One Hundred Twenty-Second General Assembly
20 is hereby fixed for Tuesday, May 24, 2022, at 1:30p.m.

21 SECTION 2. The President Pro Tempore of the Senate and
22 the Speaker of the House of Representatives may issue a joint
23 order that the General Assembly may not convene in Technical
24 Session if they determine the cost and inconvenience of meeting
25 in Technical Session are not justified.
