4 *Princeton, Indiana, will celebrate his 100th birthday;*

5 *Whereas, Born in Mt. Carmel, Illinois, Virgil enlisted in the*
6 *U.S. Army Air Force in 1942, and served as an aircraft*
7 *instruments technician and mechanic for B-24 bomber planes*
8 *during World War II as part of the 10th Air Force, 7th*
9 *Bombardment Group, 9th Bomb Squad, Company 436;*

10 *Whereas, Virgil's military service earned him several*
11 *medals, including the Asiatic-Pacific Medal and the Good*
12 *Conduct Medal;*

13 *Whereas, Virgil returned from duty in 1945 and married his*
14 *wife, Wilma, on December 25, 1949;*

15 *Whereas, For almost 40 years, Virgil worked for the A&P*
16 *grocery store in Princeton as the head butcher;*

17 *Whereas, Virgil is the father of three children, Karen, Kay,*
18 *and Ken, grandfather to Erin, Jill, Scott, and Shannon, and has*
19 *numerous nieces and nephews; and*
