6	team held off defending state champion Culver Academy to win
7	the 2019 IHSAA Class 3A state championship title;
8	Whereas, Silver Creek High School, with 881 students
9	enrolled, was founded in 1925 and is located in Sellersburg,
10	with a total population of 8,765;
11	Whereas, To get to the championship game, the Dragons
12	defeated Brownstown Central and Corydon Central to win the
13	sectional championship, Evansville Memorial and Princeton to
14	win the regional championship, and Indianapolis Crispus
15	Attucks to win the semi-state championship;
16	Whereas, Both Silver Creek and Culver Academy entered
17	the game with 24-3 records, and each team got off to a slow
18	start in the championship game, with Silver Creek holding a
19	16-12 lead at halftime, but the Dragons shot 89% during the
20	third quarter, and held on to the lead in a tight final quarter to
21	win the championship;
22	Whereas, Zane Gross led the way with 15 points, Kooper
23	Jacobi finished with 11 points, and Trey Kaufman contributed
24	six assists to the Dragons' championship effort;

1	Whereas, Zane Gross, Trey Kaufman, and Kooper Jacobi
2	were each named 1st team all-conference players, and Ty
3	Kessinger and Jack Hawkins received all conference honorable
4	mentions;
5	Whereas, All-state players for Silver Creek included Zane
6	Gross, Trey Kaufman (Super 15 Underclassmen), and Kooper
7	Jacobi (honorable mention underclassmen);
8	Whereas, Zane Gross was named 1st team academic all-
9	state and Ty Kessinger earned honorable mention academic
10	all-state honors; and
11	Whereas, Led by head coach Brandon Hoffman, Silver
12	Creek finished the season with a 25-3 record to win the first
13	state championship in school history: Therefore,
