1           A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION honoring Lisa H. Kobe  
2 upon her retirement.

3           *Whereas, Lisa H. Kobe will retire from Duke Energy on*  
4 *June 1, 2020, after 33 years of service to the company and its*  
5 *predecessors, PSI Energy and Public Service Indiana;*

6           *Whereas, Lisa joined Public Service Indiana in 1987 as a*  
7 *government affairs professional and has represented the*  
8 *company in the state legislature throughout her career;*

9           *Whereas, Lisa began her working life as an intern for the*  
10 *Indiana House of Representatives during the 1977 legislative*  
11 *session, and served two additional years as a member of the*  
12 *House staff;*

13           *Whereas, Lisa has been involved in every session of the*  
14 *Indiana General Assembly since 1977, and has brought to her*  
15 *work a deep understanding of the state legislature as well as*  
16 *the industries she represented;*

17           *Whereas, As a lobbyist for the Indiana Chamber of*  
18 *Commerce, Lisa advocated for the creation of the Indiana*  
19 *Department of Environmental Management, and later served as*  
20 *IDEM's first Director of Legislative Affairs and*  
21 *Communications;*

22           *Whereas, A tireless advocate for the electric industry, Lisa*  
23 *was awarded Duke Energy's highest honor, the James B. Duke*  
24 *Award, for her career achievements;*



1           *Whereas, Lisa has been a long-time board member of the*  
2 *Lugar Excellence in Public Service Series, providing leadership*  
3 *training experience that encourages, mentors, and prepares*  
4 *women leaders across Indiana to seek new levels of personal*  
5 *achievement and public involvement;*

6           *Whereas, Lisa has worked diligently over the course of her*  
7 *career to build trusting and bipartisan relationships with state*  
8 *legislators to achieve consensus on complex issues; and*

9           *Whereas, Lisa Kobe's retirement leaves a void in the*  
10 *Statehouse that will be difficult to fill: Therefore,*

11           *Be it resolved by the Senate of the General Assembly*  
12 *of the State of Indiana, the House of Representatives*  
13 *concurring:*

14           SECTION 1. That the Indiana General Assembly  
15 congratulates Lisa H. Kobe on the occasion of her retirement.
