## DIGEST OF INTRODUCED RESOLUTION

**Citations Affected:** The Constitution of the State of Indiana.

**Synopsis:** Vehicle joint resolution. This proposed amendment has not been previously agreed to by a general assembly.

**Effective:** This proposed amendment must be agreed to by two consecutive general assemblies and ratified by a majority of the state's voters voting on the question to be effective.

Conflict reconciliation: Text in a statute in *this style type* or *this style type* reconciles conflicts between statutes enacted by the 2021 Regular Session of the General Assembly.
