SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION No. 14

DIGEST OF INTRODUCED RESOLUTION

Citations Affected: Article 4 of the Constitution of the State of Indiana.

Synopsis: Redistricting commission. Repeals the constitutional provision for drawing legislative districts by the general assembly. Requires the general assembly to establish an independent redistricting commission to draw congressional and legislative districts. This proposed amendment has not been previously agreed to by a general assembly.

Effective: This proposed amendment must be agreed to by two consecutive general assemblies and ratified by a majority of the state's voters voting on the question to be effective.

SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION No. 14

A JOINT RESOLUTION proposing an amendment to Article 4 of the Constitution of the State of Indiana concerning elections.

Be it resolved by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

SECTION 1. The following amendment to the Constitution of the State of Indiana is proposed and agreed to by this, the One Hundred Twenty-Second General Assembly of the State of Indiana, and is referred to the next General Assembly for reconsideration and agreement.

SECTION 2. ARTICLE 4, SECTION 5 OF THE CONSTITUTION OF THE STATE OF INDIANA IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS: Section 5. (a) The General Assembly elected during the year in which a federal decennial census is taken shall fix by law the number of Senators and Representatives. and apportion them among districts according to the number of inhabitants in each district, as revealed by that federal decennial census. The territory in each district shall be contiguous.

1 (b) Not later than July 1, 2027, the General Assembly shall 2 establish by law an independent redistricting commission to draw 3 the congressional and legislative districts for the state. The 4 redistricting commission shall be politically balanced and 5 representative of Indiana voters. The redistricting commission 6 shall conduct the redistricting process in an open and transparent 7 manner and shall not favor any individual or political party.
